<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection; • Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can; • Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs; • Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19; • Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' show symptoms of COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days or until the test comes back negative; • Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well the expectations outlines in this agreement; • Communicate between home and school through social media, text, email and the school website; • Will provide first aid as and when needed by Paediatric First Aid trained staff. Staff will be wear PPE when administering first aid; 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone; • If my child, or another child in the group, shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately; • On my commute, and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules. • When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child; • Only 1 adult will drop off/ collect my child/ children; • I understand that my child uniform needs to be as clean as possible; • My child must not bring any items into school with them or take items home from school other than lunch packs, a water bottle and book bags ; • I will provide my child with a change of clothes that can remain at school until needed e.g. if my child needs changing; • My child will have their temperature taken on arrival and during the day if they feel or present as being unwell • I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully • My child will need to use good respiratory and hand hygiene; • I will not be allowed into the school without a pre- arranged appointment – make 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adhere to the social distancing rules in class and in the playground; • Tell an adult if I feel unwell • Not bring things into school from home, or take things home from school other than lunch packs, a water bottle and book bags; • Only use the equipment provided to me by school and no other; • Not to mix with any other children from a different year group while in the school; • Only enter and exit the school building from the designated areas; • Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it); • Follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds/ hand sanitiser; • Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others; • Follow these expectations and know that if I don't, I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Personal care e.g. nappy changing will still be completed as and when necessary by an adult from your child's 'bubble', wearing PPE; • Support your child with applying sun cream as and when needed 	<p>appointments via telephone or email;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this crisis; • Read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home; • I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details. • If my child is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe and follow the amended Behaviour Policy. • I understand that if my child hurts themselves, first aid will be administered by a trained first aider, wearing PPE • Understand that my child/children may struggle to separate from me but will allow the practitioners to take and comfort them as necessary.
