<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection;</li> <li>• Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can;</li> <li>• Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs;</li> <li>• Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19;</li> <li>• Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' show symptoms of COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days or until the test comes back negative;</li> <li>• Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well the expectations outlines in this agreement;</li> <li>• Communicate between home and school through social media, text, email and the school website;</li> <li>• Will provide first aid as and when needed by Paediatric First Aid trained staff. Staff will be wear PPE when administering first aid;</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone;</li> <li>• If my child, or another child in the group, shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately;</li> <li>• On my commute, and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules.</li> <li>• When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child;</li> <li>• No Parents will be allowed on to the school premises to drop off my child/ children;</li> <li>• Only 1 adult can collect my child/ children at the end of the day;</li> <li>• I understand that my child uniform needs to be as clean as possible;</li> <li>• My child must not bring any items into school with them or take items home from school other than lunch packs, a water bottle and book bags ;</li> <li>• I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully</li> <li>• My child will need to use good respiratory and hand hygiene;</li> <li>• I will not be allowed into the school without a pre- arranged appointment – make appointments via telephone or email;</li> <li>• I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Adhere to the social distancing rules in class and in the playground;</li> <li>• Tell an adult if I feel unwell</li> <li>• Not bring things into school from home, or take things home from school other than lunch packs, a water bottle and book bags;</li> <li>• Only use the equipment provided to me by school and no other;</li> <li>• Not to mix with any other children from a different year group while in the school;</li> <li>• Only enter and exit the school building from the designated areas;</li> <li>• Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it);</li> <li>• Follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds/ hand sanitiser;</li> <li>• Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others;</li> <li>• Follow these expectations and know that if I don't, I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.</li> </ul>

	<p>safe as possible' environment during this crisis;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home;</li> <li>• I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details.</li> <li>• If my child is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe and follow the amended Behaviour Policy.</li> <li>• I understand that if my child hurts themselves, first aid will be administered by a trained first aider, wearing PPE</li> <li>• Understand that my child/children may struggle to separate from me but will allow the practitioners to take and comfort them as necessary.</li> </ul>
