Reporting Positive Covid-19 Cases

It is important that you continue to report any positive cases of Covid-19 to us, even though we will not be in school.

You must report any new cases of Covid-19 by emailing the following address:

A member of staff will be monitoring this email up until Wednesday 7th April.

Any cases after this date do not need to be reported to school but would still be reported to NHS Test and Trace. Positive cases have to be reported to school up to this date so we can help identify any close contacts and speak to people if they need to self-isolate.
